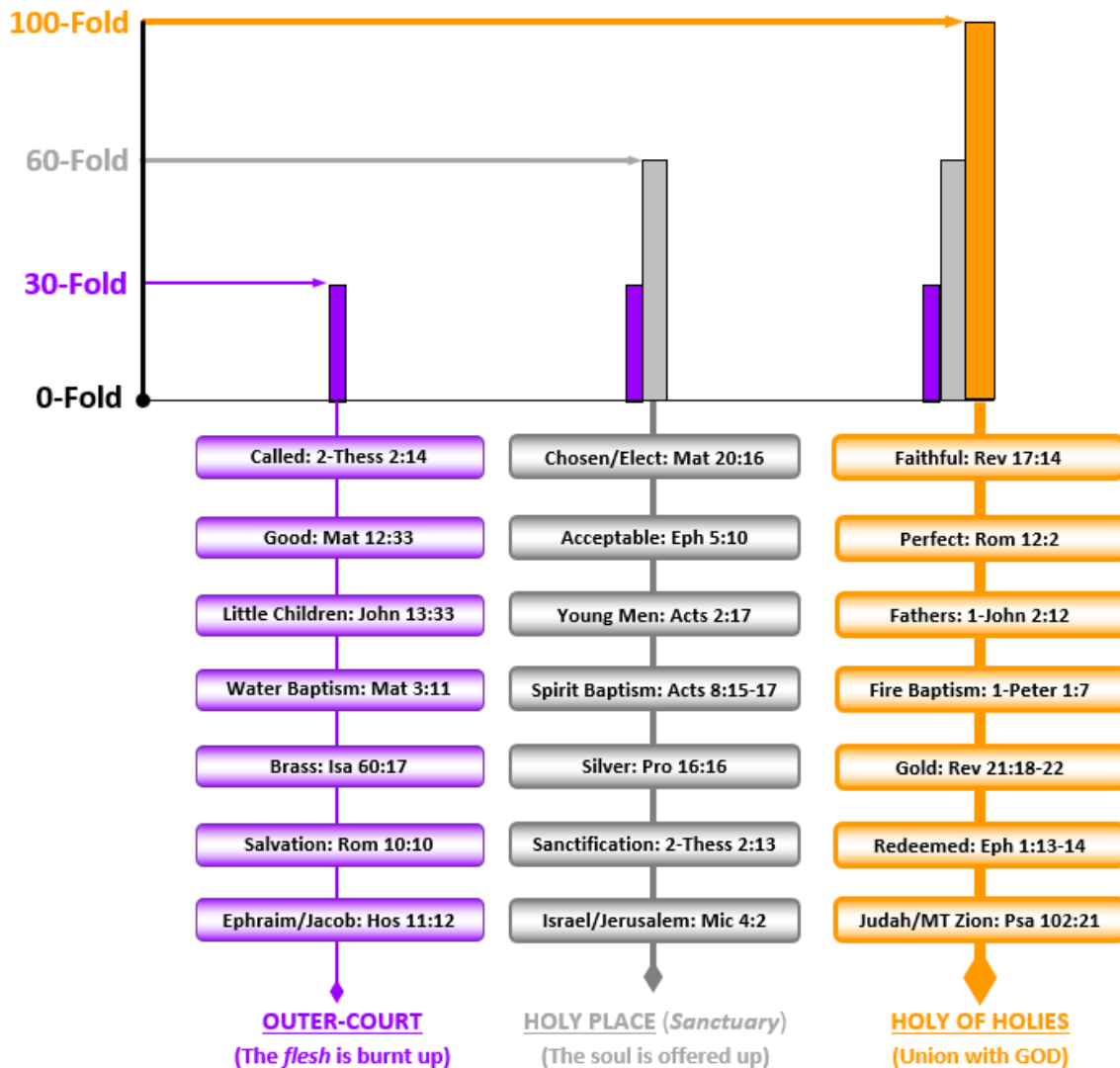


Christian Maturity/Authority Chart

The Law of the Fullness



This chart will hopefully bring to light the different levels of maturity and relationship that believers can obtain onto in this lifetime. These are not self-imposed labels that I have assigned of my own accord; they were put in the Bible because GOD very much wants us to understand our present position and condition as we stand before Him. Since 1-Corinthians 11:31 says we are to “judge ourselves,” how can we do that without some standard of conduct and relationship set before us? These degrees of precepts and levels of maturity are woven into every aspect of GOD’S Word. This principle of “degrees” is found in the three courts of the Tabernacle, the three levels or realms of the heavens, and most importantly, in our relationship with GOD. This is why the number “three” represents “the fullness” of anything in the Bible. In like manner there are three levels of authority in God’s Kingdom, three levels or degrees of judgment that God can bring forth, three basic levels of Christian maturity (relationship), etc. My hope in this short study is to quicken you to look for these segregations as you read the Bible, especially when it pertains to chronology and the progression of events.
